
# **CISCE NATIONAL YOGA COMPETITION**



Around 900 students and more than 700 parents attended today's event Compass and Confluence that marked the onset of a new era of technical education adhering to the National Education Policy 2020.


















#### **CULTURAL EXCHANGE WITH FINLAND**




